1	The Preamble Information should describe the history of adding ground gust dynamic factor to the control surface loads calculations. The proposed ground gust dynamic factor can be not less than 1.2 but no more than 1.6. No dynamic factor currently exists for §25.415 (Amd’t 91).	It would be helpful to add additional historical information into the Preamble Information for the rule.	Agreed. The NPRM will be updated to explain the rationale behind the 1.2 and 1.6 values.
