**PART 93—SPECIAL AIR TRAFFIC
RULES AND AIRPORT TRAFFIC PAT-
TERNS**

**John F. Kennedy International Airport
Traffic Area**

The purpose of this amendment to Part 93 of the Federal Aviation Regulations is to delete Subpart B of Part 93 which prescribes special air traffic rules for the John F. Kennedy International Airport traffic area.

These special rules are no longer necessary due to the decommissioning of the Floyd Bennett Naval Airport, and the establishment of the New York terminal control area; therefore, action is taken herein to delete Subpart B of Part 93.

Since this amendment removes an obsolete regulation from the Federal Aviation Regulations, notice and public procedure hereon are not necessary and good cause exists for making this amendment effective on less than 30-days notice.

In consideration of the foregoing, Subpart B of Part 93 of the Federal Aviation Regulations is deleted, effective February 10, 1972.
