



## Equipment

The basic required equipment as prescribed in the applicable airworthiness regulations (see Certification basis) must be installed in the glider for certification.

NOTE 1. Current weight and balance report including list of equipment included in certificated empty weight must be provided for each glider at the time of original certification.

NOTE 2. The following placards must be installed in full view of the pilot:

- (a) "Flight in cloud is permitted provided the following instruments of an approved type are installed:  
Altimeter and Turn and Bank."
- (b) "The breaking load of the weak link in the towing cable not to exceed 1000 lb."
- (c) "The following aerobatic maneuvers are permitted:  
loops, stall turns, tight turns, spins, chandelles."
- (d) "When flying in rough air the speed is not to exceed 76 knots IAS."
- (e) "Night flying is prohibited."

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
