




NOTE 2. Blade Model Designation The blade model designation consists of four numbers and a suffix letter. The first group of two numbers denotes the diameter of the propeller in inches. The second group of two numbers denotes the basic model number or template used. The suffix "M" denotes the blade was molded to shape. The suffix "L" denotes that the blade was laminated from plastic boards. A dash and a number added to the blade model designation indicates the amount in inches that the propeller diameter has been reduced from the basic design diameter.

For example:



A revised blade marking system initiated November 5, 1948. Blade models 7214 to 6814 are eligible at rating 100 hp at 3000 rpm.

NOTE 3. Pitch Control. Not applicable.

NOTE 4. Feathering. Not applicable.

NOTE 5. Left Hand Models. The left hand version of an approved model propeller is eligible at the same rating and diameter as listed for the right hand model. It is designated by an "L" preceding the blade model designation.
