



**Data Pertinent to All Models**

Certification Basis	FAR 31, effective July 1, 1964, including Amendments 31-1 through 31-4.
Production Basis	None.
Equipment	The basic required equipment as prescribed in the applicable airworthiness regulations (See Certification Basis) must be installed in the aircraft for certification. Additional required items of equipment are listed in the FAA Approved Avian Balloon Flight Manual.

NOTE 1      Reserved

NOTE 2      This balloon must be operated according to the FAA approved Balloon Flight Manual. The envelope temperature indicator must be placarded to indicate the maximum allowable envelope temperature. All placards required in the approved balloon flight manual must be installed in the appropriate locations.

NOTE 3      Every 100 flight hours or annually, whichever occurs first, the inspections specified in the FAA approved Airworthiness Limitations (Section 9 of the latest FAA accepted revision of Document No. ICA-1) must be accomplished.

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
