SUBJ: PART 121 APPENDIX H RESTRICTED AIRLINE TRANSPORT PILOT CERTIFICATES


1. PURPOSE. This order establishes procedures for the issuance of limited pilot certificates obtained under the provisions of Phase IIA of the Advanced Simulation Plan (Amendments 61-69, and 121-161).
2. DISTRIBUTION. This order is distributed to all Flight Operations offices in Washington, Flight Standards offices in regions, Flight Standards National Field Office (to the branch level), and to all Air Carrier, General Aviation, and Flight Standards District Offices.
3. BACKGROUND. Information in this order was previously issued as Notice 8430.335 dated November 5, 1980. Appendix H to Part 121, which was established by Amendment 121-161, describes a three phase plan whereby an operator may upgrade its present simulators or purchase new simulators so that an increased amount of pilot training and checking can be accomplished in those simulators. One aspect of this plan is described in Phase IIA. Phase IIA is an interim phase which permits an operator to utilize a simulator approved under Phase I to accomplish the training and checking allowed under Phase II. Phase IIA exists to encourage operators to participate in the advanced simulation plan and to offer an incentive for the continued upgrading of simulators approved under Phase I. Phase IIA requires that each participating pilot in command receive operating experience including 25 flight hours and 5 landings and that each second in command receive 15 flight hours and 3 landings following the training received under that phase. To assure that participating pilots who receive airline transport pilot certificates and associated type ratings under Phase IIA do not exercise the privileges of that certificate or rating outside of Part 121 operations, it will be necessary to place a limitation on such certificates until the operating experience requirements of Phase IIA have been met.
4. ACTION.
 - a. Any inspector who issues an airline transport pilot certificate (ATPC) with an associated type rating on that certificate based on a check conducted in a Phase 1 simulator under the provisions of Phase IIA of Part 121, Appendix H, shall place the following restriction on the Temporary Airman Certificate, FAA Form 8060-4: "ATPC and (airplane type as appropriate) privileges valid for FAR Part 121 operations only." See Appendix 1 for an example. If a type rating is added to an existing ATPC under the provisions of Phase IIA of Part 121, Appendix H, the following restriction will be placed on the certificate: "(Airplane type as appropriate) rating valid for FAR Part 121 operations only." See Appendix 2 for an example. Issuance of a limited certificate under the provisions of this order should not result in deletion of any previously issued privileges or ratings. The certificate and associated paperwork should be processed through the Airman

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Certification Branch at Oklahoma City in the normal manner. The blocks next to "aircraft flight check" in the evaluator's record section of the Airman Certificate and/or Rating Application, FAA Form 8410-2, should not be checked. The statement "Phase IIA" should be entered next to the words "Simulator Check" and N/R (Not Required) should be entered on the signature line next to "aircraft flight check." See Appendix 3 for an example.

b. A pilot who is issued a restricted certificate should be instructed to report to the district office with proof that he/she has completed the operator experience requirements of Phase IIA for removal of the restriction. At that time, the restricted certificate should be surrendered and a new temporary certificate issued without the restriction. A copy of the new temporary and the old certificate should be sent to the Airman Certification Branch along with a new FAA Form 8410-2. The "reissuance of certificate" block at the top of this form should be checked. On the back of the form in the remarks section the following entry should be made: "Phase IIA operating experience completed (Date)." (See Appendix 4.)
