Subject: Deviation to FAA Order 8120.2G Paragraphs 2-20 and 2-27b(1)

This memorandum authorizes a deviation to FAA Order 8120.2G, Production Approval and Certificate Management Procedures, paragraphs 2-20 and 2-27b(1). This deviation allows the Manufacturing Inspection Office (MIO) to delegate the application for, or an amendment to, a production certificate (PC) to respective Manufacturing Inspection District Offices (MIDO) or Certificate Management Offices (CMO).

If delegated, PC holders will be notified that when submitting FAA Form 8110-12, Application for a Type Certificate, Production Certificate, or Supplemental Type Certificate, for an amendment to a production limitation record, the form should be sent directly to their geographic MIDO/CMO instead of their MIO.

This deviation will be incorporated into the next change or revision to FAA Order 8120.2. Additionally, since the requirement to send a PC application is also in Advisory Circular 21-43, Production Under 14 CFR Part 21, Subparts F, G, K, and O, this deviation will be incorporated into its next revision. This deviation cancels the June 11, 2012 deviation with the same subject.
