



Subject: Clarification: Use of Block 12 on Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Form 8130-3, Authorized Release Certificate, Airworthiness Approval Tag

This memorandum provides clarification on the use of the statements “Domestic shipment only” and “Not an export approval.” These statements are not required to be included in Block 12 (Remarks) of FAA Form 8130-3, *Authorized Release Certificate, Airworthiness Approval Tag*. For more information, refer to FAA Order 8130.21H, *Procedures for Completion and Use of the Authorized Release Certificate, FAA Form 8130-3, Airworthiness Approval Tag*.

When issuing a FAA Form 8130-3 for an export airworthiness approval, the originator must ensure all negotiated terms for export to other countries which the FAA has a bilateral agreement are met.
