This memo grants a deviation to FAA Order 8100.8C "Designee Management Handbook," Change 5, paragraph 803.f. for all Acoustical Designated Engineering Representatives (DERs) and Organization Designation Authorization unit members (UMs) regarding recurrent seminar attendance every two years.

The FAA has offered a DER Recurrent Seminar Technical session for acoustics every two years from 1999 until 2007 and then changed to even-year offerings in 2008. This change in the seminar schedule resulted in a three year gap between session offerings for those who last attended the Acoustical Technical session in 2007.

This memo serves as a one-time extension of the two-year recurrent seminar attendance requirement (General and Technical sessions) to three years for Acoustical DERs/UMs. This extension will allow them to synchronize with the new schedule and meet future training requirements. Each ACO advisor or organization management team member that manages acoustical DERs or ODAs with acoustical authority will contact their assigned DER/ODA holder and explain this deviation, discuss any relevant policy from the 2008/2009 DER seminars and provide any guidance that is requested.
