



Subject: INFORMATION: Deviation to Order 8100.7E Change 1, Aircraft Certification
Systems Evaluation Program

This is in response to ASW-180 memorandum of November 7, 2012, requesting a deviation from FAA Order 8100.7E change 1, Aircraft Certification Systems Evaluation Program (ACSEP), paragraph 2-1. Specifically, the memorandum requested that a new employee be authorized to participate as an evaluator-in-training prior to attending the formal on-line/classroom ACSEP evaluation training. This request is based on the fact that the employee's MIDO is scheduled to support numerous ACSEP evaluations before the next formal classroom session is offered.

Due to the limited on-line/classroom training offerings during FY2013, AIR-200 approves the requested deviation effective immediately for all evaluators-in-training. This deviation will remain valid through FY2013. Evaluators-in-training must successfully complete the formal on-line/classroom components of ACSEP training prior to their participation as a member of an ACSEP evaluation team.
