Instructions for Continued Airworthiness contained in Era Aviation Services, Emergency Skid Mounted Flotation System Step Actuators installed on Bell Helicopter Model 412/412EP, Document Number 41232-62, Revision IR, dated March 3, 2003, or later FAA-accepted revision is required. The installer must determine whether this design change is compatible with previously approved modifications.
