Description of the Type Design Change: Installation of electrical wiring provisions for cargo loading system in forward and aft lower cargo compartment in accordance with AES Master Drawing List B737-1000, Revision "C," dated June 1, 1999, and AES Engineering Change Order (ECO) 737-001, Revision "F," dated June 11, 1999, or later FAA approved revisions.

Limitations and Conditions: The approval of this change in type design applies to the above model airplanes only. This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated, unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of the aircraft. A copy of this Certificate and AES ECO 737-001, Revision "F," dated June 1, 1999, or later FAA approved revisions to these drawings must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft. This approval is limited to the installation of electrical wiring provisions for the cargo loading system and shall not be extended to the cargo loading units or control panels. Installation of the wiring provisions in the forward lower cargo compartment is approved for Model 737-800/-900 series airplanes. Aft lower cargo compartment wiring provisions are approved for Model 737-600/-700/-800/-900 series airplanes.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
