Operated in accordance with Rotorcraft Flight Manual Supplement (RFMS) dated July 10, 1998, or later FAA-approved revision.

*Limitations and Conditions:* Approval of this change applies to the above noted helicopter models only when equipped with the high skid landing gear and cargo mirror. This approval should not be extended to other rotorcraft of these models on which other approved modifications are incorporated, unless it is determined that the interrelationship between this change and any previously approved modifications will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of the rotorcraft. A copy of this certificate and the MDL must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified rotorcraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

*This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.*
