*Description of the Type Design Change:* Installation of a digital Electronics International exhaust gas temperature (E.G.T.) gauge (P/N ET-1) in accordance with Electronics International ET-1 Maintenance Manual, Section X, and an alternate means of correcting the indicated Exhaust Gas Temperature (EGT) reading when the EGT Compensation System is either inoperative or removed from the aircraft.

NOTE: This replaces the Howell temperature indicator, P/N 3850305-5050.

*Limitations and Conditions:* Approval of this change in type design applies to the above model aircraft only. This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. A copy of this Certificate, Electronics International ET-1 Maintenance Manual, and the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) approved Airplane Flight Manual Supplement, SP-06-003, Revision IR, dated November 29, 2006 shall be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

*This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.*
