Rotorcraft modified in accordance with this STC must be operated with an FAA approved copy of the Rotorcraft Flight Manual Supplement (RFMS), Heli-Trade Document HT205-15.2-RFMS, dated May 11, 2006, or later FAA approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions: Approval of this change in type design applies to the above model rotorcraft only. This approval should not be extended to rotorcraft of these models on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. A copy of this certificate, the Instructions for Continued Airworthiness, and the RFMS shall be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.
