Description of the Type Design Change: Modification of main rotor blade Part Number 6415-20601-041, -042, and -043 in accordance with Master Drawing List DM0326-3, Revision A, dated April 16, 2008, or later Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) approved revision. Note that after the modification the blade is re-identified to Part Number HTS6415-20601-041, -042, or -043. Retirement life for the modified main rotor blade, Part Number HTS6415-20601-041, -042, or -043, is 20,000 hours total time in service from original manufacture.

Limitations and Conditions: This approval should not be extended to other rotorcraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that rotorcraft. Inspect and maintain the HTS6415-20601-041, -042, and -043 rotor blades per Instructions for Continued Airworthiness (ICA) DM0326-10, Revision A, dated November 17, 2009, or later FAA-accepted revision.

A copy of this certificate and ICA must be maintained as part of the permanent record of the modified rotorcraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
