Limitations and Conditions: Instructions for Initial and Continued Airworthiness, Document AMI-STC-F10-107, Revision "New," dated October 30, 2002 (or latest approved revision), is a required part of this STC. The Airplane Flight Manual Supplement to the Falcon 10, S/N 107, Airplane Flight Manual, AeroMech Document F10-02-107S, Revision "Original," FAA approved October 31, 2002, or latest FAA approved revision, is required on-board for operation of the aircraft. Descriptive data pertaining to this design change are considered inadequate for duplication on other products. This approval is limited to the Dassault Model Falcon 10, Serial Number 107 only.

This approval should not be extended to other specific airplanes of these models on which previously modification is incorporated, unless it is determined that the interrelationship between this approval and any of those previously approved modifications will introduce no adverse effects upon the airworthiness of that airplane.

A copy of this certificate must be maintained as part of the permanent records of the aircraft. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of the permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
