Limitations and Conditions: Approval of this change in type design applies to HTSI Model CH-54B Serial Numbers listed above only. Rotorcraft modified in accordance with this supplemental type certificate must be operated in accordance with an FAA-approved copy of the HTSI Rotorcraft Flight Manual Supplement (RFMS), "Installation of Single Point Fixed Pendant P/N HTS-LB-001," Revision C, FAA-approved June 28, 2006, or later FAA-approved revision. A copy of this certificate, FAA approved RFMS, and the ICA must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified rotorcraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.
