A copy of this Certificate and JAMCO America, Inc., Master Drawing List IA-104MDL must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft. For installation of Kits JAG747001-024 and JAG747001-900, Supplemental Type Certificate (STC) ST01523SE, interior reconfiguration, must be installed concurrently.
