1. FAA Approved Balloon Flight Manual Supplement, dated September 7, 2010, or later FAA approved revisions required.
2. Descriptive data pertaining to this design change are considered inadequate for duplication in other products. This approval is limited to only the installation made in Cameron Balloons Ltd. Model A-210, S/N 6258, only. This STC does not permit manufacturing of parts for multiple installations.
