Description of the Type Design Change: Installation of a satellite television system on McDonnell Douglas DC9-32 aircraft in accordance with Flight Structures, Inc. Master Drawing List (MDL) 98FS857-D01, Revision A, dated 3/20/00, or later FAA approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions: This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined by the installer that the relationship between this change and other previously approved modification will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of the aircraft. A copy of this certificate and the MDL specified above must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft. STC ST09649SC must be installed prior to or concurrently with this STC. The STC holder will provide a written permission statement to each person it authorizes to use this certificate to alter the product.

The airplane must be maintained in accordance with Flight Structures, Inc. Supplemental Instructions for Continued Airworthiness – Live TV Installation on Legend Air DC-9-32 Aircraft, including the FAA approved Airworthiness Limitations Section 3, Document Number 98FS857-D86, Revision IR, or later FAA approved revision. The live TV Installation is life limited to 2300 flight cycles, or one year, whichever occurs first.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
