Limitations and Conditions (Continued):

2. The basket, burner and fuel cylinders must be operated in accordance with their manufacturer's Flight Manual(s) as listed in the applicable Type Certificate as noted in the "Eligibility List" Drawing no. SB90 rev. 6 dated July 21, 2005.
3. The envelope must be maintained in accordance with Fantasy Sky Promotions Free Flight Hot Air Balloon Maintenance Manual, Issue 2, dated March 13, 1992 or later Transport Canada approved revisions.
4. The basket, burners and fuel cylinders must be maintained in accordance with their manufacturers Maintenance Manuals(s) as listed in the applicable Type Certificate as noted in the "Eligibility List" Drawing no. SB90 rev. 6 dated July 21, 2005.
5. When combining any envelope with any basket/burner system, the component with the lowest Maximum Allowable Weight will be chosen as the Maximum Allowable All Up Weight for the combination of components.
6. A copy of this certificate along with a copy of the "Eligibility List" Drawing no. SB90 rev. 6, dated July 21, 2005 or later Transport Canada approved revisions will be attached to the applicable Fantasy Sky Promotions Flight Manual, Issue 2, Transport Canada approved March 13, 1992 of later Transport Canada approved revisions.
7. The AX-8 (105,000 cu.ft.) when certified to the higher Maximum Allowable All Up Weight of 1,800 lbs and the AX-9-122 must always be equipped with dual burners. Minimum burner system allowed for these balloons are as follows:
 - For Thunder and Colt, Double Mark 2 or Magnum burners or subsequent.
 - For Cameron, Double Mark IV burners or subsequent.
 - For Aerostar (Raven), Double Mark HP burners or subsequent.
 - For Lindstrom (Kempner), Jestream Double burners or subsequent.
 - For Balloon Works (Sidney Conn), T3-017 Double burners or subsequent
8. Fantasy Sky Promotions to provide a copy of their balloon flight manual to each operator that purchases a fantasy envelope under this STC.
9. Compatibility of this design change with previously approved modifications must be determined by the installer.
10. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use the certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.
