Description of Type Design Change:

Installation of an adjustable trim tab on the left aileron in accordance with Aero-Trim, Inc., Model 400 Data List, Revision "AB", or later FAA Approved Revision; Installation Drawing Nos. 437 and 451 pertain to Piper PA-34-200 and PA-34-200T airplanes.

The approval of this change applies basically to the Piper PA-34 models listed above only. This approval should not be extended to other airplanes of this model

Limitations and Conditions: on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined by the installer that the interrelationship between this change and any of those previously approved modifications will produce no adverse affect upon the airworthiness of that airplane. This determination should include consideration of significant changes in weight distribution such as an increase in the fixed disposable weight in the fuselage. FAA approved AFM Supplement or "POH and FAA approved AFM" Supplement dated March 31, 1981, is a required part of this STC.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
