Description of Type Design Change: Reduced Vertical Separation Minimum (RVSM) group airworthiness approval of specific Dassault Aviation Fan Jet Falcon and Mystere-Falcon 20 aircraft in accordance with Kohlman Systems Research (KSR) Master Drawing List – Falcon 20 Group RVSM Drawing No. MDL1017, Rev. “OR”, dated July 25, 2005, or later FAA approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions:

- 1) This approval is limited to specific Dassault Aviation aircraft (see attached AML No. ST01349WI). Descriptive data pertaining to this design change are considered inadequate for duplication on other products.
- 2) This STC does not approve avionics equipment or software modifications. Independent approval and incorporation of a prerequisite dual Air Data Computer system installation is required (see attached AML No. ST01349WI).
- 3) An FAA Approved Airplane Flight Manual Supplement (see attached AML No. ST01349WI) is required to be on board during operation of the aircraft in RVSM airspace.
- 4) Compatibility of this design change with previously approved modifications must be determined by the installer.
- 5) If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of the permission.
- 6) A copy of this certificate must be maintained as part of the permanent records of the aircraft.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
