(HTSI) Master Drawing List No. HTS-AESMDL-001, Revision IR, dated February 13, 2003, or later Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) approved revision. This modification must be maintained in accordance with HTSI Maintenance Manual Supplement Document No. HTS-AESICA-001, dated February 13, 2002, or later FAA approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions: Approval of this change in type design applies to only HTSI Model CH54B rotorcraft as listed above. This approval should not be extended to other rotorcraft of these models on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that helicopter. A copy of this Certificate and Maintenance Manual Supplement must be maintained as part of the permanent record of the modified helicopter.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
