This approval should not be extended to other specific airplanes of these models on which previous modifications are incorporated, unless it is determined that the interrelationship between this approval and any of those previously approved modifications will introduce no adverse effects upon the airworthiness of that airplane. Descriptive data pertaining to this design change are considered inadequate for duplication on other products. This approval is limited to Dassault Model Falcon 20-C5, Serial Number 135 only.

A copy of this certificate must be maintained as part of the permanent records of the aircraft. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of the permission.
