Instructions for Continued Airworthiness, Report EGR-766-12, Revision A, dated May 07, 2004, FAA accepted dated August 24, 2004, or later FAA accepted revision is required for Long TREC installation.
4. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.
