**Description of the Type Design Change:** Installation of Rockwell Collins Four Tube FDS 2000 Electronic Flight Instrument System (EFIS) and Rockwell Collins AHC 3000 Attitude Heading Reference System (AHRS) per HELIPRO Corporation International Master Drawing List (MDL) HP 76-34-00-103, Revision N/C, dated February 16, 2004, or later FAA approved revision. This modification must be maintained in accordance with the HELIPRO Corporation International Maintenance Manual Supplement, Documents HP 76-05-00-251 revision N/C, HP 76-05-00-252 revision N/C, and HP 76-05-00-253 revision N/C dated September 8, 2003 or later FAA accepted revisions.

**Limitations and Conditions:** Approval of this change in type design applies to the above model rotorcraft only. This approval should not be extended to rotorcraft of these models on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. Rotorcraft modified in accordance with this STC must be operated with an FAA approved copy of the Rotorcraft flight Manual Supplement (RFMS), Helipro International Document No. FRMS HP 76-34-00-301, Revision "A", dated March 24, 2006, or later FAA approved Revision. A copy of this certificate, the maintenance manual supplement and the RMFS shall be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

**This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.**
