Installation of an Oil Tank Safety Cap Adapter which is intended to prevent loss of oil in the event of loss or damage to the oil filler cap, per Propulsion Technology Corp., Drawing PT08001, Rev F, dated: July 24, 1990 or PTM International, Inc. Drawing PT08001, Revision L, Sheet 1 thru 5, dated May 5, 1994, or later FAA approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions: This approval should not be extended to other engines of this model that incorporate any other previously approved modifications, unless it is determine that the interrelationship will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that engine model. This installation is limited to a maximum pressure altitude of 37,000 feet. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission."
