NOTE: This modification requires the installation of auxiliary Ventral Stabilizer Fins as per Jobmaster, Inc. Drawing No. J76-118 or the standard DeHavilland ventral fin.

Note. No fins required with the 1000 HP PZL engine installation.

Limitations and Conditions: This approval is limited to the installation in the DeHavilland Model DHC-3, only. This approval should not be extended to other aircraft on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined by the installer that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. A copy of this Certificate and FAA Approved Jobmaster Flight Manual Supplement must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.
