Description of the Type Design Change: Install modified engine cowl per Cascade Flying Service Master Drawing List CFS-MDL-PT 0001, Revision A, dated April 10, 2001, and Cascade Flying Service Document CFS-IM-106, "Installation Instructions for Forced Air Induction Cowling, PT6A Powered Air Tractor" Revision IR, dated October 23, 2000, or later FAA approved revisions.

Limitations and Conditions: Approval of this change in type design applies to the above model aircraft only. This approval should not be extended to aircraft of these models on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. A copy of this Certificate must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.

The modified aircraft must be maintained in accordance with the provisions of Cascade Flying Service Document CFS-MM-109, "Maintenance Manual Supplement," Revision IR, dated January 21, 2001, or later FAA approved revision.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
