Limitations and Conditions: This air filter installation must be maintained in accordance with FDC document 1350-SERIES-ICA-1, Revision D, dated February 11, 2008, or later FAA-approved revision. Approval of this change in type design applies to the above model rotorcraft and including AS350B3 helicopters incorporating Eurocopter Modification No. AMS OP 3082 (Dual Hydraulics) only. This approval should not be extended to other rotorcraft of these models on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined by the installer that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that rotorcraft.

A copy of this certificate and the FAA-approved Rotorcraft Flight Manual Supplement 1350-1200, Revision H, dated May 6, 2008, or later FAA-approved revision, must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified rotorcraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
