This approval should not be extended to other rotorcraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effects upon the airworthiness of that rotorcraft. A copy of this Certificate must be maintained as part of the permanent record of the modified rotorcraft. This is a direct replacement part, and the FAA has determined that no Instructions for Continued Airworthiness are required.
