This modification must be maintained in accordance with Eagle Helicopters, Incorporated Instruction for Continued Airworthiness (ICA), as defined on the attached AML, or later FAA-approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions: Approval of this change in type design is limited to the models of rotorcraft listed on the attached AML. This approval should not be extended to rotorcraft of these type models which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any of those previously approved modifications, including any change in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. Rotorcraft modified in accordance with this Supplemental Type Certificate (STC) must be operated with an FAA-approved copy of the Rotorcraft Flight Manual Supplement (RFMS), as defined on the attached AML, or later FAA-approved revision. A copy of this certificate, the ICA, and the RFMS must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
