1. Sikorsky S61N Rotorcraft Flight Manual SA 4045-82 revised October 27, 2008 or later FAA approved revision is required with this conversion.
2. Sikorsky S61N Maintenance Manual SA 4045-80 Rev. 47 dated November 30, 2011 or later FAA approved revision is required for Continued Airworthiness of this conversion.
3. Life limited parts shall be retired in accordance with Sikorsky Service Bulletin No. 61B General – 1Y Revision 24 dated April 19, 2004 or later FAA approved revision “Time Limits, establishment of and serialization of retireable parts”.
4. Installation of type design change per supplement type certificate (STC), SH640NE is a prerequisite installation for this conversion.
5. This conversion is limited to land based operations only; amphibious conversion will require further FAA approval.
6. You cannot use descriptive data about this design change to duplicate other products. This approval is limited to only the installation made in Sikorsky, S-61L Serial No. 61428. This STC does not permit manufacturing of parts for multiple installations.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
