Install in accordance with Isolair, Inc. Installation Manual as specified by AML SR01858SE.

Limitations and Conditions: This modification requires the installation of the KAWAK Aviation Technologies, Inc., Model 36000 Auxiliary Hydraulic System per Supplemental Type Certificate SR01288SE. This approval should not be extended to other rotorcraft of these models on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated, unless it is determined by the installer that the interrelationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that rotorcraft.

Maintain the Isolair, Inc., Eliminator II Model 4600-S61 Fire Fighting System installation in accordance with Isolair, Inc., Instructions for Continued Airworthiness (ICA) Manual as specified by AML SR01858SE. The modified rotorcraft must be operated in accordance with an FAA-approved copy of Isolair, Inc., Rotorcraft Flight Manual Supplements (RFMS), as defined in the AML. A copy of this certificate, the FAA-approved RFMS and the ICA must be maintained as part of the permanent records of the modified rotorcraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
