Description of Type Design Change: Install external retardant tank in accordance with FAA sealed Aero Union Drawing List No. AU3100. Aircraft must be loaded in accordance with FAA approved Aero Union Weight and Balance Report No. WB001 dated June 30, 1973, and operated in accordance with FAA approved Aero Union Supplement No. MS001 dated October 5, 1977, or later FAA approved revision to Airplane Flight Manual 19501(UAL) and 14748(TAI). Applies to UAL aircraft serial numbers 44893 through 44902, 45131 through 45137 and 45491 through 45494 onl. Applies to TAI aircraft serial numbers 43833, 43834, 44696, and 44697 only.

Limitations and Conditions: The approval of this change in type design applies basically to the DC-6B airplane only. This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined by the installer that the interrelationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. This determination should include consideration of significant changes in weight distribution such as increase in the fixed disposable weight (including ballast) in the fuselage. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter a product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration
