Description of Type Design Change: Increase the seating arrangement from 26F/387Y to 42F/387Y by converting the upper deck lounge to first class seating with sixteen seats. Install an auxiliary galley in Zone B and replace the upper deck galley with a new galley. All of this will be accomplished in accordance with United Air Lines, DAS-1-WE, Approved List No. 1132 dated December 18, 1981, or later FAA approved revisions.

Limitations and Conditions: This approval should not be extended to other specific aircraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated, unless it is determined that the interrelationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft.
