The modified airplane must be operated in accordance with Aerocet FAA-approved Supplemental Airplane Flight Manual (SAFM) listed on AML SA02000SE, and maintained with Instructions for Continued Airworthiness, A-10035, Revision 0, dated April 29, 2009, or later FAA-accepted revisions.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
