The modified aircraft must be maintained in accordance with Fliegen Works Instructions for Continued Airworthiness and Component Maintenance Manual (ICA), document number FW-IMC407-13, Revision B, dated March 18, 2010, or later FAA-accepted revision, and operated in accordance with the FAA-approved Rotorcraft Flight Manual Supplement (RFMS) as listed on AML SR01822SE, or later FAA-approved revision.

This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined by the installer that the relationship between this change and any of the other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft.

A copy of this certificate, the AML, the FAA-approved RFMS, and the ICA must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
