Installation of two Lycoming TIO-540-A2B turbocharged engines and two Hartzell HC-E3YR-2/C8468-6R propellers; or installation of Lycoming TIO-540-J2BD or -N2BD and LTIO-540-J2BD or -N2BD engines with Hartzell HC-E3RY-2F/FC8468-6R or -8R and HC-E3YR-2LF/FJC8468-6R or -8R propellers and gross weight as shown in the appropriate AFM Supplements listed below, according to Drawing Summary Revision S, EO.31072A dated September 9, 1974, and EO.32E-1 dated October 8, 1974.

Limitations and Conditions:

FAA Approved Airplane Flight Manual Supplement dated March 10, 1970, or October 3, 1974, is required for Cessna Model 320E; Supplement dated March 9, 1973, is required for Cessna Model 320C. Cessna 320C approved with TIO-540-A2B engines only; Cessna 320E approved with TIO-540-J2BD or -N2BD and LTIO-540-J2BD or -N2BD only. The installer must determine whether this design change is compatible with previously approved modifications. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter a product, the holder must give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
