3. Maintenance to be performed in accordance with Honeywell Instructions for Continued Airworthiness Document No. 3028-0009-GP, Revision B, dated May 14, 2012, FAA accepted December 31, 2013, or later FAA accepted revisions.
4. Aircraft is to be operated in accordance with Honeywell Rotorcraft Flight Manual Supplement No. 3028-0026-GP, Revision IR, FAA approved April 02, 2014.

Limitations and Conditions:

1. FAA STC SR02120NY-D must be installed prior to the installation of the VXP Upgrade.
2. The installer must determine whether this design change is compatible with previously approved modifications.
3. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder must give the other person written evidence of that permission.
