Fabrication of Helipro spar replacement system in accordance with McClenahan Master Drawing List specified on AML No. SR00767SE, or later Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) approved revision; and installation of this system in accordance with Helipro Installation Instruction Report specified on AML SR00767SE, or later FAA approved revision. This modification must be maintained in accordance with Helipro Maintenance Manual Supplement Report, or Instructions for Continued Airworthiness Report specified on AML SR00767SE, or later FAA approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions:

Approval of this change in type design applies to rotorcraft models specified on AML SR00767SE, only, that are equipped with standard tail booms and empennages. This approval should not be extended to other rotorcraft of these models on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that helicopter.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

No Rotorcraft Flight Manual Supplement was deemed necessary for this modification. A copy of this Certificate, AML, SR00767SE, and FAA approved Maintenance Manual Supplement or Instructions for Continued Airworthiness must be maintained as part of the permanent records of the modified helicopter.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, and revoked or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
