Description of the Type Design Change: Fabrication of Dart D119-675-011 and -012 Heli-Access-Steps in accordance with Dart Aerospace Drawing List No. MDL-D119-675, Revision D, dated November 12, 2007, or later Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) approved revision; and installation of this system in accordance with Dart Aerospace Installation Instructions, Document No. IIN-D119-675, Revision B, dated October 23, 2007, or later FAA-approved revision. This modification must be maintained in accordance with Instructions for Continued Airworthiness, Document No. ICA-D119-675, Revision 1, dated October 23, 2007, or later FAA-approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions: Approval of this change in type design applies to Agusta Models A119 and AW119 MKII rotorcraft only. It has not been demonstrated that this modification meets the requirements for Human External Cargo. It is intended that a load be placed on this step only when the rotorcraft is on the ground. This approval should not be extended to other rotorcraft of these models on which previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined by the installer that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that rotorcraft. A copy of this certificate and the Instructions for Continued Airworthiness must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified rotorcraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
