These skid tubes must be maintained in accordance with DART Instructions for Continued Airworthiness (ICA) No. ICA-D105-674, dated March 17, 2000, or later FAA-approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions: Approval of this change in type design applies only to the rotorcraft models listed above. This approval should not be extended to other rotorcraft of these models on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined by the installer that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that rotorcraft. A copy of this certificate and the ICA must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified rotorcraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
