Description of the Type Design Change: Modification of main rotor blade part number 61170-20201 in accordance with Master Drawing List RR 9633-08, Revision A, dated September 17, 2002, or later FAA approved revision. Note that the drawings include inspection of each blade to ensure airworthy condition prior to modification. Retirement life for the modified main rotor blade, part number RR-61170-20201 is 21,200 hours total time in service.

Limitations and Conditions: This approval should not be extended to other rotorcraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that rotorcraft. A copy of this Certificate must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified rotorcraft. The modified rotor blades must be maintained IAW the "Instruction for Continued Airworthiness, STC SR01127SE, S-61 Main Rotor Blades, RR-61170-20201 Series", Revision 1, dated November 14, 2007, or later FAA approved revision. Prior to return to service of a modified blade any prior or current repairs, which are not approved in the ICA, must be substantiated and FAA approved to the new life limit of 21,200 hours.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
