Limitations and Conditions: This approval should not be extended to other specific airplanes of these models on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated, unless it is determined by the installer that the interrelationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. All installations subsequent to August 30, 1973, require the use of Airplane Flight Manual Supplement, Revision A.
