Description of the Type Design Change: Installation of passenger Service Unit Assemblies modified to include 22 minute duration oxygen generators at all locations except the seat row immediately aft of station 740.0 in accordance with TRAMCO Top Drawing 90-005 Revision B, dated June 21, 1990.

Limitations and Conditions: The approval of this change in type design applies to the aircraft model 757-223 only and should not be extended to other aircraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. A copy of this Certificate must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.
