This approval should not be extended to aircraft of these models on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. This certificate must be maintained as part of the helicopter. The Rotorcraft AEG Accepted Maintenance Manual Supplement C07-2/28-00-01, Rev. 1, dated October 27, 2005 must be maintained as part of the helicopter instructions for continued airworthiness.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
