*Description of the Type Design Change:* Installation and inspection of emergency medical stretcher and base, and oxygen system, in accordance with LifePort, Inc. Report No. EGR-603-12, Revision A, dated January 13, 2000, and Master Drawing List EGR-603-00, Revision G, dated February 10, 2000, or later FAA approved revision.

Note: This installation includes provisions for mounting equipment in the cabin interior (via equipment sleds, arches, and cabinets). Equipment mounted on these provisions, which is not specified in the above drawing package, requires separate FAA approval.

*Limitations and Conditions:* Approval of this change in type design applies to the above model aircraft only. This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of these models on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. A copy of this Certificate and FAA approved LifePort Airplane Flight Manual Supplement No. EGR-603-11, Revision IR, dated February 22, 2000, or later FAA approved revision, must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

*This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.*
